- WHO** Conley Outreach is partnering with Heartland Counseling and area volunteers to bring this special program to the Kaneland and surrounding communities.
- WHAT** RAINBOWS is a 14-week program for kids in kindergarten through 8th grade who are grieving a loss. RAINBOWS helps kids learn, heal and grow through this life transition. RAINBOWS is not a therapy group. It is a safe place for children to talk to each other about their experiences and feelings. The RAINBOWS program groups children by age and type of loss and uses trained facilitators to lead children through the grieving process.
- WHEN** RAINBOWS meets in two 7-week sessions during the school year. The first session begins in October and ends just before Thanksgiving. The second session begins in mid-January and ends in early March. Contact us for meeting times.
- WHERE** RAINBOWS meets at the Kaneville United Methodist Church, 46w764 Main Street, Kaneville IL 60144. The church is wheelchair accessible and centrally located within the district.
